**The Inclusive Governance Project** has been looking at the inclusion of people with intellectual disability.



Inclusive Governance works best when people with intellectual disability are included in all parts of an organisation.



There are **5 Principles of Inclusive Governance**.  
These principles guide the way organisations work.



**1.** We include people with intellectual disability when we are making decisions. We value this inclusion.



**2.** We make it easy for people with intellectual disability to get involved in our organisation.



**3.** We make our Board meetings and activities easier for people with intellectual disability to take part.



**4.** We provide the support that people need.



**5.** We do whatever is needed to make Inclusive Governance work.
